Currently, 44.6% of the 61,143 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 42.7%, renter occupied; and 12.7% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.4% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.3% are renter occupied; and 11.3% are vacant. In 2010, there were 57,008 housing units in the area - 43.7% owner occupied, 41.0% renter occupied, and 15.3% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 3.16%. Median home value in the area is \$137,193, compared to a median home value of \$235,127 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.52% annually to \$155,396.
