The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 52.5 in the identified area, compared to 65.1 for the U.S. as a whole.

Current median household income is \$36,498 in the area, compared to \$62,203 for all U.S. households. Median household income is projected to be \$39,276 in five years, compared to \$67,325 for all U.S. households

Current average household income is \$51,063 in this area, compared to \$90,054 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$56,108 in five years, compared to \$99,510 for all U.S. households

Current per capita income is \$19,386 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$34,136. The per capita income is projected to be \$21,281 in five years, compared to \$37,691 for all U.S. households

Currently, 30.7% of the 80,835 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 50.6%, renter occupied; and 18.7% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.4% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.3% are renter occupied; and 11.3% are vacant. In 2010, there were 76,742 housing units in the area - 30.2% owner occupied, 49.4% renter occupied, and 20.3% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 2.34%. Median home value in the area is \$132,106, compared to a median home value of \$235,127 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 3.71% annually to \$158,465.
