The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 59.9 in the identified area, compared to 65.1 for the U.S. as a whole.

Currently, 48.4% of the 13,058 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 40.8%, renter occupied; and 10.7% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.4% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.3% are renter occupied; and 11.3% are vacant. In 2010, there were 12,327 housing units in the area - 53.8% owner occupied, 35.1% renter occupied, and 11.1% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 2.59%. Median home value in the area is \$141,228, compared to a median home value of \$235,127 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 1.22% annually to \$150,079.
