Current average household income is \$124,492 in this area, compared to \$90,054 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$137,372 in five years, compared to \$99,510 for all U.S. households

Current per capita income is \$44,945 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$34,136. The per capita income is projected to be \$49,615 in five years, compared to \$37,691 for all U.S. households

Currently, 78.6% of the 58,670 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 17.2%, renter occupied; and 4.2% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.4% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.3% are renter occupied; and 11.3% are vacant. In 2010, there were 51,506 housing units in the area - 79.3% owner occupied, 15.2% renter occupied, and 5.4% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 5.96%. Median home value in the area is \$271,657, compared to a median home value of \$235,127 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 1.48% annually to \$292,368.
