Current median household income is \$67,004 in the area, compared to \$62,203 for all U.S. households. Median household income is projected to be \$72,329 in five years, compared to \$67,325 for all U.S. households

Current average household income is \$85,688 in this area, compared to \$90,054 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$94,178 in five years, compared to \$99,510 for all U.S. households

Current per capita income is \$30,374 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$34,136. The per capita income is projected to be \$33,381 in five years, compared to \$37,691 for all U.S. households

Currently, 64.9% of the 75,540 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 28.0%, renter occupied; and 7.1% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.4% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.3% are renter occupied; and 11.3% are vacant. In 2010, there were 68,853 housing units in the area - 66.0% owner occupied, 24.7% renter occupied, and 9.3% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 4.21%. Median home value in the area is \$170,904, compared to a median home value of \$235,127 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 1.47% annually to \$183,870.
