Current median household income is \$66,073 in the area, compared to \$64,730 for all U.S. households. Median household income is projected to be \$75,658 in five years, compared to \$72,932 for all U.S. households

Current average household income is \$83,948 in this area, compared to \$90,054 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$95,424 in five years, compared to \$103,679 for all U.S. households

Current per capita income is \$29,197 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$34,136. The per capita income is projected to be \$33,188 in five years, compared to \$39,378 for all U.S. households

Currently, 67.5% of the 37,184 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 26.0%, renter occupied; and 6.5% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 57.3% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.2% are renter occupied; and 11.5% are vacant. In 2010, there were 33,811 housing units in the area - 65.9% owner occupied, 24.9% renter occupied, and 9.3% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 4.32%. Median home value in the area is \$211,863, compared to a median home value of \$264,021 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 3.04% annually to \$246,107.

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
