The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 64.3 in the identified area, compared to 65.1 for the U.S. as a whole.

Current average household income is \$71,442 in this area, compared to \$90,054 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$80,138 in five years, compared to \$99,510 for all U.S. households

Currently, 41.4% of the 46,329 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 49.6%, renter occupied; and 8.9% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.4% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.3% are renter occupied; and 11.3% are vacant. In 2010, there were 42,274 housing units in the area - 42.1% owner occupied, 46.5% renter occupied, and 11.4% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 4.15%. Median home value in the area is \$205,261, compared to a median home value of \$235,127 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.20% annually to \$228,843.
