The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 65.4 in the identified area, compared to 65.1 for the U.S. as a whole.

Current average household income is \$69,229 in this area, compared to \$90,054 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$77,817 in five years, compared to \$99,510 for all U.S. households

Current per capita income is \$26,774 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$34,136. The per capita income is projected to be \$30,249 in five years, compared to \$37,691 for all U.S. households

Currently, 36.7% of the 32,265 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 54.1%, renter occupied; and 9.2% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.4% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.3% are renter occupied; and 11.3% are vacant. In 2010, there were 29,875 housing units in the area - 37.4% owner occupied, 50.5% renter occupied, and 12.1% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 3.48%. Median home value in the area is \$209,224, compared to a median home value of \$235,127 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.25% annually to \$233,815.
