Currently, 62.2% of the 56,125 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.0%, renter occupied; and 5.8% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 58.5% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.7% are renter occupied; and 9.8% are vacant. In 2020, there were 53,305 housing units in the area and 6.2% vacant housing units. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2020 is 1.60%. Median home value in the area is \$208,043, compared to a median home value of \$308,943 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 0.96% annually to \$218,186.

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
