Currently, 63.8% of the 105,860 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.0%, renter occupied; and 5.3% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 58.2% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.8% are renter occupied; and 10.0% are vacant. In 2020, there were 104,039 housing units in the area and 5.5% vacant housing units. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2020 is 0.77%. Median home value in the area is \$292,014, compared to a median home value of \$283,272 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.24% annually to \$326,242.
