Current average household income is \$58,365 in this area, compared to \$90,054 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$63,873 in five years, compared to \$99,510 for all U.S. households

Current per capita income is \$21,261 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$34,136. The per capita income is projected to be \$23,339 in five years, compared to \$37,691 for all U.S. households

Currently, 35.7% of the 22,868 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 43.8%, renter occupied; and 20.5% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.4% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.3% are renter occupied; and 11.3% are vacant. In 2010, there were 20,718 housing units in the area - 42.4% owner occupied, 40.9% renter occupied, and 16.8% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 4.49%. Median home value in the area is \$146,941, compared to a median home value of \$235,127 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 1.20% annually to \$155,964.
