The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 67.6 in the identified area, compared to 72.1 for the U.S. as a whole.

The number of families in the current year is 73,458 in the specified area.

Current average household income is \$141,143 in this area, compared to \$107,008 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$159,287 in five years, compared to \$122,048 for all U.S. households

Current per capita income is \$53,048 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$41,310. The per capita income is projected to be \$60,171 in five years, compared to \$47,525 for all U.S. households

Currently, 67.8% of the 115,234 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 27.8%, renter occupied; and 4.4% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 58.5% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.7% are renter occupied; and 9.8% are vacant. In 2020, there were 113,886 housing units in the area and 4.7% vacant housing units. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2020 is 0.36%. Median home value in the area is \$396,910, compared to a median home value of \$308,943 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 0.87% annually to \$414,556.

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
