Current median household income is \$108,329 in the area, compared to \$72,603 for all U.S. households. Median household income is projected to be \$122,153 in five years, compared to \$82,410 for all U.S. households

Current average household income is \$144,989 in this area, compared to \$107,008 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$163,864 in five years, compared to \$122,048 for all U.S. households

Current per capita income is \$53,340 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$41,310. The per capita income is projected to be \$60,545 in five years, compared to \$47,525 for all U.S. households

Currently, 73.7% of the 74,041 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 22.5%, renter occupied; and 3.9% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 58.5% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.7% are renter occupied; and 9.8% are vacant. In 2020, there were 73,804 housing units in the area and 4.1% vacant housing units. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2020 is 0.10%. Median home value in the area is \$394,975, compared to a median home value of \$308,943 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 0.78% annually to \$410,702.

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
