Persons of Hispanic origin represent 10.2% of the population in the identified area compared to 19.4% of the U.S. population. Persons of Hispanic Origin may be of any race. The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 70.8 in the identified area, compared to 72.1 for the U.S. as a whole.

The five-year projection of households is 66,909, a change of 1.24% annually from the current year total. Average household size is currently 2.54, compared to 2.55 in the year 2020. The number of families in the current year is 40,632 in the specified area.

Current median household income is \$69,724 in the area, compared to \$72,603 for all U.S. households. Median household income is projected to be \$80,368 in five years, compared to \$82,410 for all U.S. households

Current average household income is \$93,595 in this area, compared to \$107,008 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$109,410 in five years, compared to \$122,048 for all U.S. households

Current per capita income is \$35,581 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$41,310. The per capita income is projected to be \$41,885 in five years, compared to \$47,525 for all U.S. households

Currently, 49.0% of the 70,374 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 40.4%, renter occupied; and 10.6% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 58.5% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.7% are renter occupied; and 9.8% are vacant. In 2020, there were 65,226 housing units in the area and 10.7% vacant housing units. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2020 is 2.36%. Median home value in the area is \$246,048, compared to a median home value of \$308,943 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 1.63% annually to \$266,792.
