The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 67.1 in the identified area, compared to 72.1 for the U.S. as a whole.

The number of families in the current year is 29,511 in the specified area.

Current average household income is \$78,210 in this area, compared to \$107,008 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$91,411 in five years, compared to \$122,048 for all U.S. households

Currently, 40.8% of the 64,661 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 51.9%, renter occupied; and 7.3% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 58.5% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.7% are renter occupied; and 9.8% are vacant. In 2020, there were 62,698 housing units in the area and 7.3% vacant housing units. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2020 is 0.95%. Median home value in the area is \$232,616, compared to a median home value of \$308,943 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 0.87% annually to \$242,881.

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
