Currently, 31.8% of the 32,932 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 59.9%, renter occupied; and 8.3% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 58.5% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.7% are renter occupied; and 9.8% are vacant. In 2020, there were 32,174 housing units in the area and 8.1% vacant housing units. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2020 is 0.72%. Median home value in the area is \$201,201, compared to a median home value of \$308,943 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 0.88% annually to \$210,243.
