The number of families in the current year is 19,929 in the specified area.

Current average household income is \$81,829 in this area, compared to \$107,008 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$96,099 in five years, compared to \$122,048 for all U.S. households

Current per capita income is \$32,042 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$41,310. The per capita income is projected to be \$37,919 in five years, compared to \$47,525 for all U.S. households

Currently, 40.8% of the 44,290 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 51.4%, renter occupied; and 7.8% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 58.5% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.7% are renter occupied; and 9.8% are vacant. In 2020, there were 43,220 housing units in the area and 8.0% vacant housing units. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2020 is 0.76%. Median home value in the area is \$263,340, compared to a median home value of \$308,943 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 1.56% annually to \$284,487.

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
