The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 67.1 in the identified area, compared to 72.1 for the U.S. as a whole.

The number of families in the current year is 13,893 in the specified area.

Current median household income is \$51,814 in the area, compared to \$72,603 for all U.S. households. Median household income is projected to be \$60,254 in five years, compared to \$82,410 for all U.S. households

Current average household income is \$78,359 in this area, compared to \$107,008 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$92,189 in five years, compared to \$122,048 for all U.S. households

Current per capita income is \$31,567 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$41,310. The per capita income is projected to be \$37,454 in five years, compared to \$47,525 for all U.S. households

Currently, 37.9% of the 32,784 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 54.1%, renter occupied; and 8.0% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 58.5% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.7% are renter occupied; and 9.8% are vacant. In 2020, there were 32,079 housing units in the area and 8.0% vacant housing units. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2020 is 0.67%. Median home value in the area is \$252,621, compared to a median home value of \$308,943 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 1.61% annually to \$273,678.

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
