The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 84.0 in the identified area, compared to 72.1 for the U.S. as a whole.

The household count in this area has changed from 200,551 in 2020 to 204,634 in the current year, a change of 0.62% annually. The fiveyear projection of households is 208,779, a change of 0.40% annually from the current year total. Average household size is currently 2.45, compared to 2.47 in the year 2020. The number of families in the current year is 109,803 in the specified area.

Current average household income is \$112,414 in this area, compared to \$107,008 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$129,797 in five years, compared to \$122,048 for all U.S. households

Current per capita income is \$45,249 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$41,310. The per capita income is projected to be \$52,602 in five years, compared to \$47,525 for all U.S. households

Currently, 45.3% of the 221,438 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 47.1%, renter occupied; and 7.6% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 58.5% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.7% are renter occupied; and 9.8% are vacant. In 2020, there were 217,098 housing units in the area and 7.6% vacant housing units. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2020 is 0.61%. Median home value in the area is \$363,230, compared to a median home value of \$308,943 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 1.15% annually to \$384,591.

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
