The five-year projection for the population in the area is 131,953 representing a change of -0.30% annually from 2023 to 2028. Currently, the population is 46.9% male and 53.1% female.

The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 60.0 in the identified area, compared to 72.1 for the U.S. as a whole.

The fiveyear projection of households is 51,807, a change of -0.18% annually from the current year total. Average household size is currently 2.51, compared to 2.52 in the year 2020. The number of families in the current year is 33,421 in the specified area.

Current average household income is \$67,952 in this area, compared to \$107,008 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$79,012 in five years, compared to \$122,048 for all U.S. households

Currently, 52.3% of the 59,931 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 34.9%, renter occupied; and 12.8% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 58.5% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.7% are renter occupied; and 9.8% are vacant. In 2020, there were 60,167 housing units in the area and 12.4% vacant housing units. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2020 is -0.12%. Median home value in the area is \$154,658, compared to a median home value of \$308,943 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 1.35% annually to \$165,361.

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
