The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 66.4 in the identified area, compared to 72.1 for the U.S. as a whole.

The number of families in the current year is 22,291 in the specified area.

Current average household income is \$80,570 in this area, compared to \$107,008 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$94,050 in five years, compared to \$122,048 for all U.S. households

Currently, 76.4% of the 36,693 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 15.9%, renter occupied; and 7.6% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 58.5% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.7% are renter occupied; and 9.8% are vacant. In 2020, there were 33,231 housing units in the area and 8.6% vacant housing units. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2020 is 3.10%. Median home value in the area is \$228,798, compared to a median home value of \$308,943 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 0.34% annually to \$232,705.
