Currently, 44.1% of the 21,521 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 42.7%, renter occupied; and 13.2% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 58.5% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.7% are renter occupied; and 9.8% are vacant. In 2020, there were 21,047 housing units in the area and 13.0% vacant housing units. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2020 is 0.69%. Median home value in the area is \$242,034, compared to a median home value of \$308,943 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.40% annually to \$272,548.

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
