Current median household income is \$103,452 in the area, compared to \$72,603 for all U.S. households. Median household income is projected to be \$117,162 in five years, compared to \$82,410 for all U.S. households

Current average household income is \$152,412 in this area, compared to \$107,008 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$172,790 in five years, compared to \$122,048 for all U.S. households

Current per capita income is \$63,606 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$41,310. The per capita income is projected to be \$72,473 in five years, compared to \$47,525 for all U.S. households

Currently, 55.7% of the 116,936 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 38.4%, renter occupied; and 5.9% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 58.5% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.7% are renter occupied; and 9.8% are vacant. In 2020, there were 115,623 housing units in the area and 6.0% vacant housing units. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2020 is 0.35%. Median home value in the area is \$470,041, compared to a median home value of \$308,943 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 0.94% annually to \$492,573.

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
