Currently, 65.8% of the 115,978 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 30.1%, renter occupied; and 4.0% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 58.2% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.8% are renter occupied; and 10.0% are vacant. In 2020, there were 112,155 housing units in the area and 4.3% vacant housing units. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2020 is 1.50%. Median home value in the area is \$267,565, compared to a median home value of \$283,272 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 1.36% annually to \$286,235.
