The five-year projection for the population in the area is 401,393 representing a change of 1.04% annually from 2023 to 2028. Currently, the population is 50.8% male and 49.2% female.

The five-year projection of households is 190,057, a change of 1.40% annually from the current year total. Average household size is currently 1.97, compared to 1.98 in the year 2020. The number of families in the current year is 64,948 in the specified area.

Current average household income is \$129,610 in this area, compared to \$107,008 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$149,733 in five years, compared to \$122,048 for all U.S. households

Current per capita income is \$60,736 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$41,310. The per capita income is projected to be \$71,315 in five years, compared to \$47,525 for all U.S. households

Currently, 38.5% of the 200,544 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 49.9%, renter occupied; and 11.6% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 58.5% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.7% are renter occupied; and 9.8% are vacant. In 2020, there were 189,933 housing units in the area and 11.5% vacant housing units. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2020 is 1.69%. Median home value in the area is \$454,070, compared to a median home value of \$308,943 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 1.94% annually to \$499,877.

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
