The five-year projection for the population in the area is 580,323 representing a change of 0.82% annually from 2023 to 2028. Currently, the population is 49.8% male and 50.2% female.

The fiveyear projection of households is 271,665, a change of 1.12% annually from the current year total. Average household size is currently 2.04, compared to 2.05 in the year 2020. The number of families in the current year is 104,330 in the specified area.

Currently, 38.9% of the 290,230 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 49.6%, renter occupied; and 11.5% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 58.5% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.7% are renter occupied; and 9.8% are vacant. In 2020, there were 277,603 housing units in the area and 11.5% vacant housing units. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2020 is 1.38%. Median home value in the area is \$409,122, compared to a median home value of \$308,943 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.40% annually to \$460,530.

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
