The five-year projection for the population in the area is 109,998 representing a change of 1.44% annually from 2023 to 2028. Currently, the population is 49.8% male and 50.2% female.

The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 57.3 in the identified area, compared to 72.1 for the U.S. as a whole.

The number of families in the current year is 26,840 in the specified area.

Currently, 63.3% of the 38,243 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.5%, renter occupied; and 5.2% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 58.5% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.7% are renter occupied; and 9.8% are vacant. In 2020, there were 34,475 housing units in the area and 5.7% vacant housing units. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2020 is 3.24%. Median home value in the area is \$368,007, compared to a median home value of \$308,943 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 0.71% annually to \$381,216.

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
