Currently, 57.7% of the 3,217 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 29.2%, renter occupied; and 13.2% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 58.5% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.7% are renter occupied; and 9.8% are vacant. In 2020, there were 3,039 housing units in the area and 14.3% vacant housing units. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2020 is 1.77%. Median home value in the area is \$251,461, compared to a median home value of \$308,943 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.82% annually to \$289,000.
