Currently, 65.3% of the 76,656 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 30.0%, renter occupied; and 4.7% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 58.5% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.7% are renter occupied; and 9.8% are vacant. In 2020, there were 75,876 housing units in the area and 4.9% vacant housing units. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2020 is 0.32%. Median home value in the area is \$233,525, compared to a median home value of \$308,943 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.96% annually to \$270,131.
