Current median household income is \$70,360 in the area, compared to \$62,203 for all U.S. households. Median household income is projected to be \$76,799 in five years, compared to \$67,325 for all U.S. households

Current average household income is \$105,840 in this area, compared to \$90,054 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$116,338 in five years, compared to \$99,510 for all U.S. households

Current per capita income is \$44,375 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$34,136. The per capita income is projected to be \$48,763 in five years, compared to \$37,691 for all U.S. households

Currently, 42.3% of the 139,210 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 47.8%, renter occupied; and 9.9% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.4% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.3% are renter occupied; and 11.3% are vacant. In 2010, there were 125,075 housing units in the area - 43.2% owner occupied, 44.2% renter occupied, and 12.6% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 4.87%. Median home value in the area is \$289,361, compared to a median home value of \$235,127 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.33% annually to \$324,664.
