The five-year projection for the population in the area is 272,558 representing a change of 0.34% annually from 2024 to 2029. Currently, the population is 47.5% male and 52.5% female.

Persons of Hispanic origin represent 14.7% of the population in the identified area compared to 19.6% of the U.S. population. Persons of Hispanic Origin may be of any race. The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 61.5 in the identified area, compared to 72.5 for the U.S. as a whole.

The fiveyear projection of households is 104,489, a change of 0.79% annually from the current year total. Average household size is currently 2.64, compared to 2.68 in the year 2020. The number of families in the current year is 61,209 in the specified area.

Current median household income is \$55,832 in the area, compared to \$79,068 for all U.S. households. Median household income is projected to be \$65,506 in five years, compared to \$91,442 all U.S. households.

Current average household income is \$72,510 in this area, compared to \$113,185 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$85,473 in five years, compared to \$130,581 for all U.S. households.

Current per capita income is \$27,279 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$43,829. The per capita income is projected to be \$32,848 in five years, compared to \$51,203 for all U.S. households.

Currently, 40.4% of the 109,353 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 51.5%, renter occupied; and 8.1% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 57.9% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.1% are renter occupied; and 10.0% are vacant. In 2020, there were 107,454 housing units in the area and 8.7% vacant housing units. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2020 is 0.41%. Median home value in the area is \$219,240, compared to a median home value of \$355,577 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 5.82% annually to \$290,844.

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
