Current median household income is \$109,050 in the area, compared to \$79,068 for all U.S. households. Median household income is projected to be \$126,253 in five years, compared to \$91,442 all U.S. households.

Current average household income is \$161,426 in this area, compared to \$113,185 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$185,196 in five years, compared to \$130,581 for all U.S. households.

Current per capita income is \$82,697 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$43,829. The per capita income is projected to be \$97,442 in five years, compared to \$51,203 for all U.S. households.

Currently, 35.5% of the 162,226 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 53.2%, renter occupied; and 11.3% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 57.9% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.1% are renter occupied; and 10.0% are vacant. In 2020, there were 151,279 housing units in the area and 10.8% vacant housing units. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2020 is 1.66%. Median home value in the area is \$670,281, compared to a median home value of \$355,577 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 1.99% annually to \$739,797.
